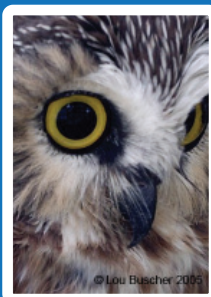

Franklin Roosevelt once said that “All that is within me cries out to go back to my home on the Hudson River.” He built his Presidential Library in Hyde Park to attract visitors and because he planned to retire here. Eleanor Roosevelt was also devoted to Dutchess County, starting a furniture factory to help local men find work and living at Val-Kill after she left the White House.

The Trustees of the Franklin D. Roosevelt Presidential Library and Museum host the annual **Family Fun Festival** to give back to the community that Franklin and Eleanor loved so much.

Throughout their lives, the Roosevelts worked to break down barriers for disenfranchised citizens all over the world, to pave the way for a better future. **The Franklin and Eleanor Roosevelt Hudson Valley Vision Award** was created to recognize those who exceed expectations in working to improve the future of the Hudson Valley for ALL people, through engagement and inclusion.
