Franklin Roosevelt once said that "All that is within me cries out to go back to my home on the Hudson River." He built his Presidential Library in Hyde Park to attract visitors and because he planned to retire here. Eleanor Roosevelt was also devoted to Dutchess County, starting a furniture factory to help local men find work and living at Val-Kill after she left the White House.
