## PAPERS OF THE WOMEN'S DIVISION OF THE

### DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL COMMITTEE

1933-1944

This collection (89 linear feet, 139 containers, 12 volumes) comprises the papers of the Women's Division of the Democratic National Committee. The bulk pertains to the campaigns of 1936 and 1940. Few of the 1932 campaign materials are present, and after 1940 the papers are incomplete. The Women's Division conducted its affairs independently of the Democratic National Committee. During these years the Division was headed successively by Miss Mary Dewson (1932-1934), Mrs. James H. Wolfe (1935-1936), Mrs. Thomas F. McAllister (1937-1940), and Mrs. Charles W. Tillett (1940-1946).

The papers contain correspondence with the National Chairmen and other leaders of the Party; with leaders of Democratic women's organizations in the States and, to a lesser extent, in the counties; materials relating to arrangements for speakers and radio broadcasts; relating to the preparation and publication of the Democratic Digest and other campaign literature; and pertaining to the Division's Reporter Plan for accumulating and distributing data on New Deal programs and projects for use by Party workers. The materials are arranged in four series as follows:

#### Containers 1-12

(A) General Correspondence for the period 1933-1937 arranged alphabetically by name of correspondent and by subject headings. The material in this series is primarily concerned with Division matters on a national level. Included in this file is correspondence between Division members and National Chairman James A. Farley and others on patronage and problems generally affecting women in the Party; and pertaining to national committees and organizations. Material for 1937 may also be found in series (D).

#### Containers 13-71

(B) Correspondence for the period 1933-1937 arranged alphabetically by State. Each State file contains correspondence arranged by name of correspondent and by counties, a file "State Chairman, U.S. Senators and Congressmen," and "Miscellaneous Correspondence." Correspondence originating with the State Chairwoman and other prominent Democratic women is generally filed under their names, and correspondence regarding political campaigns in the counties is filed under the county. Material in this series is primarily concerned with the Division's activities in the States and relates to the organization of Party machinery, preparation and dissemination of campaign literature, and the development and use of various techniques devised by the Division for the education of women voters. Material for 1937 may also be found in series (C).

Boxes 71-106

(C) Correspondence for the period 1937-1944 arranged alphabetically by State. Each State file contains correspondence arranged by name of correspondent and by counties, a file "State Chairman, U.S. Senators and Congressmen," and "Miscellaneous Correspondence."

Correspondence originating with the State Chairwoman and other prominent Democratic women is generally filed under their names, and correspondence regarding political campaigns in the counties is filed under the county. Material in this series is primarily concerned with the Division activities in the States and related to the organization of Party machinery, the preparation and dissemination of campaign literature, and the development and use of various techniques devised by the Division for the education of women voters. Material for 1937 may also be found in series (B).

Boxes 106-139

(D) General Correspondence for the period 1937-1944 arranged alphabetically under name of correspondent and subject headings. The material in this series is primarily concerned with Division matters on a national level. Included in this file is correspondence for the campaigns of 1936-1944; exchanges with prominent Democratic leaders and material pertaining to national committees and organizations. Filed at the end of this series are printed and processed material, and several loose-leaf binders and scrapbooks of news clippings. Material for 1937 may also be found in series (A).
