These papers were donated to the Franklin D. Roosevelt Library by President Franklin D. Roosevelt. Roosevelt began shipping Presidential materials to the Library in August 1940 but the bulk of the collection was received from his estate in December 1947. President Roosevelt donated his copyright interest in these papers to the United States Government; writings of other individuals are subject to copyright restrictions under Title 17 of the U.S. Code.

Related Material: The papers of Franklin D. Roosevelt as President are divided into five major groups: the Alphabetical File, the Official File, the President's Personal File, the President's Secretary's File, and the Map Room Papers. Most of the Library's other collections will also contain related material on given topics.

Introductory Note

THE PRESIDENT'S ALPHABETICAL FILE

The President's Alphabetical File contained three major categories of material: referral sheets to correspondence received at the White House but sent to appropriate government agencies for response, cross reference sheets to items of correspondence which were filed elsewhere in the White House files, and correspondence from the general public. The file occupied approximately 3,000 linear feet of shelving. Only about one quarter of its volume was composed of correspondence from the general public; referral and cross reference sheets comprised most of the remainder (approximately 60 percent and 15 percent respectively). Studies conducted by members of the Library's staff suggest that as one moved through the years of Roosevelt's presidency, the percentage of correspondence in the file declined, while that of referral and cross reference sheets increased.

The Alphabetical File was, for the most part, a file of last resort. Most of the correspondence from the general public which referred to topics of importance to the White House -- to other matters, that is, than requests for jobs, pensions, small favors and the like, and other than general effusions of support for and opposition to Roosevelt and his policies -- was filed under appropriate headings in the President's Official File and the President's Personal File, and a large (619 box)

file within the latter of these -- PPF 200, designated "public reaction letters" and divided into several sub-files -- holds only material of this type. The material which reached the Alphabetical File is that which the White House staff chose to file, by the name of the sender (with a few exceptions), within the huge alphabetical runs, almost uninterrupted by subject headings, of which this file was composed.

The Alphabetical File was divided into three series, corresponding roughly to the three completed terms of office (the material from the few months of the fourth term being added to the series for the third). The material from the first series (from 1933 through 1936) which fell between the alphabetical sequence Aa to Fleming, Miner F., was microfilmed in the early 1950s and survives in its entirety. The remnant of the rest of the file which survives, representing about 2 percent of the original, was selected in 1976 through random sampling techniques. In addition, a few subject files were removed from the material to be destroyed and filed in their appropriate places within that which was preserved. Their date spans, when different from those of the series in which they are located, are indicated in parentheses. A shelf list for the 178 rolls of microfilmed material is attached as an appendix.
